TASTING NOTE:

Made from 100% Pinot Noir grown in Western Cape, this Cap Classique is full of finesse and energy. Vibrant aromas of ripe strawberries, cranberries, and hints of rose petals on the palate. A balanced mouthfeel with lingering acidity and minerality.

SERVE WITH:

Versatile and best served with light seafood, smoked salmon, Asian flavors, or berry desserts.

A bright salmon pink colour with a delicate mousse.

ORIGIN:

Western Cape (Stellenbosch and Robertson)

VINEYARD AND CLIMATE CONDITIONS:

Pinot Noir grapes selected from two vineyard blocks in Stellenbosch and Robertson were harvested in the cool, early morning, ensuring a sugar content of 18.5° – 19.5° Balling for optimal freshness.

WINEMAKING:

The grapes were whole bunch pressed with minimal rotations and interference to preserve quality. The juice was fermented in temperature-controlled stainless-steel tanks. Only the finest tanks were chosen for blending. Secondary fermentation took place in the bottle with extended aging on the lees for ± 14 months prior to disgorging.



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
